



CODE OF CONDUCT

- Athletes are expected to be committed to the program and respectful of their coaches and teammates.
- Players are responsible for notifying coaches of an absence.
- Academics and study should be a priority before sports.
- Players will notify the coach of any tournament conflict at least one month prior to the event.

If a player leaves a tournament it will be considered they are quitting the team.

- No player, parent, or coach shall make any disparaging remark about, or gesture toward another player, team, coach, or official.
- **Palm Beach Juniors has a no tolerance policy for alcohol consumption, smoking, or drug abuse.**
- **No boys are allowed in player's hotel room.**
- **Players must not leave their room after specified curfew time.**
- Players and parents are responsible for leaving all gymnasiums clean.

Any damage to a hotel room will be charged to all athletes assigned to that room on an equal basis, unless athlete reports the party responsible for the damage prior to departure.
